The Southern Oregon Viticulture and Enology Scholarship is an Employer Match scholarship is available for employees, including owners, of Oregon Vineyards/Wineries/Tasting Rooms. The ERATH Family Foundation (EFF) established this scholarship to increase the number of personnel in Southern Oregon leadership roles who have a fundamental education in V&E.

Through a generous donation by the EFF, vineyards and wineries can support and encourage their employees to attend the Southern Oregon Wine Institute at Umpqua Community College by matching up to \$2,000 per academic year per student/employee, for a total of up to \$4,000 per academic year per student/employee.

HOW DOES THIS SCHOLARSHIP WORK?

- 1. Vineyard/Winery/Tasting Room Owner/Employer may choose one or more employees they will help fund to attend SOWI (up to \$2,000 matched per academic year).
- 2. The scholarship will match up to \$2,000 per academic year for the employee/student that has matching funding assistance from their employer (tuition, fees, and books).
- 3. Scholarship funds are payable to the student's/employee's UCC student account upon receipt of the application and employer's sponsorship portion.
- 4. Employers may pay the full \$2,000 (or any lesser amount) sponsorship payment at the beginning of the academic year to be indicated for a specific term or spread throughout the whole academic year. The term or division between terms will be selected on the application form.
- 5. Employers may also pay per term as enrollment (number of credits taken per term) may fluctuate.
- 6. All funds go towards tuition, fees, books, and other educational costs. Overpayments will not be matched or carried over to another academic year.
- 7. Funding availability is on a first come, first serve basis. Please submit application and receive verification before mailing check.
- 8. Checks should be made payable to Umpqua Community College, not the UCC Foundation.
- 9. Employee/Student must be enrolled in one of the following programs:
 - a. AAS Viticulture and Enology
 - b. Certificate in Viticulture
 - c. Pathway Certificate Wine Marketing Assistant
 - d. English Language Learnings students may apply their ELL courses to their V&E course load

WHEN DO I NEED TO APPLY?

Deadlines for application: Prior to the start of each term in which the funds are being delegated for use.
